### **BEGINNER WATERCOLOR**

Designed for the beginner & intermediate student – you are sure to gain knowledge and skill under artist, Norma Jones. Students will learn basic watercolour techniques and the drawing skills required to complete the paintings. The first class will concentrate on painting from a still life; further classes will depend upon student preferences. The class has an open framework and accommodates individual projects and styles. Students are encouraged to bring pictures or ideas they would like to work from.

**Supplies Needed:** Bring any watercolour supplies you have. Some paints, brushes and paper will be included in registration fee. Recommended you have: pencil; kneading eraser; watercolour brushes - good quality #4 to #6 round and #8 to #12 rounds; wash brush; some watercolour paper - good quality 140 to 250lb; watercolour palette or white styrofoam egg carton; masking and butcher's tape (brown 1 ½"); Exacto-knife; thumb tacks or medium weight staple gun; hair dryer; paper towel; small pkg Kleenex; watercolour paints - suggested colours: alizarin crimson, ultramarine blue, aureolin yellow, burnt sienna, sap or hooker's green; optional colours: Payne's gray, Windsor or Grumbacher red, Prussian blue, yellow ochre; all participants should bring a ¼ - ½ " thick board about 18" x 22" , if possible.
